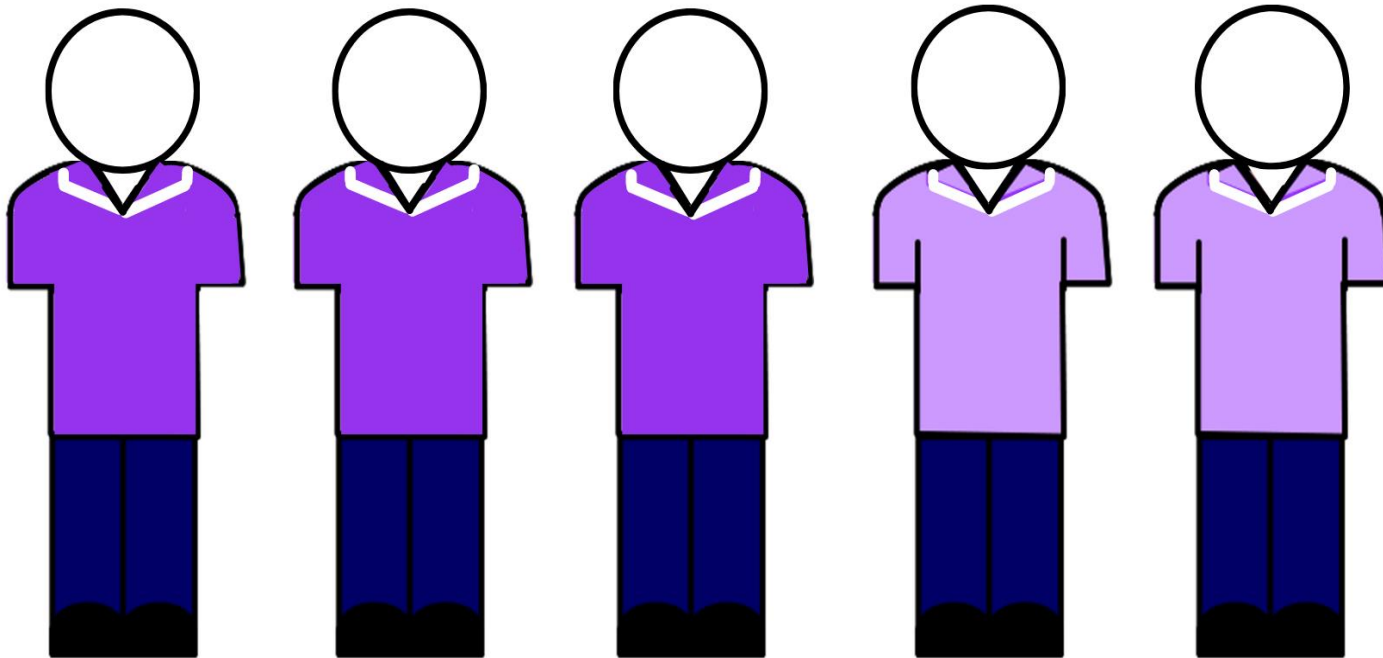

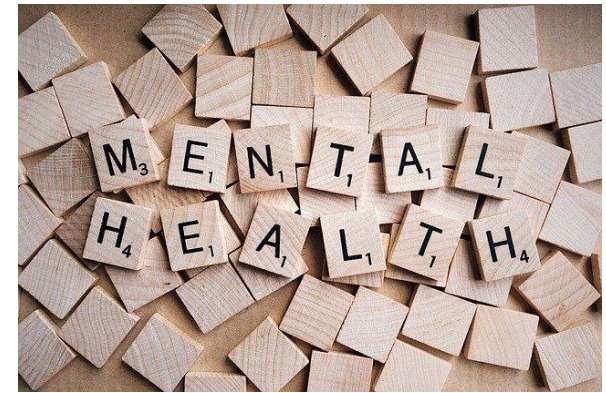
Where could you be placed?

What happens during a shift?





What happens during a shift?

Early shift

- Start at 7 to 7:30 am (depending on area)
- Receive handover and patient allocations
- Assist patients to get up, washed and dressed
- Preparing patients for theatre, scans and procedures
- Assist with breakfast, feeding patients, repositioning and toileting
- Complete observations and documentation
- Have a break
- Prepare patients for lunch
- Assist with lunches, feeding patients and completing nutrition charts
- Late-shift staff arrive
- Complete observations, repositioning and hand over outstanding duties to late staff
- Finish shift between 3 to 3:30 pm (depending on area)

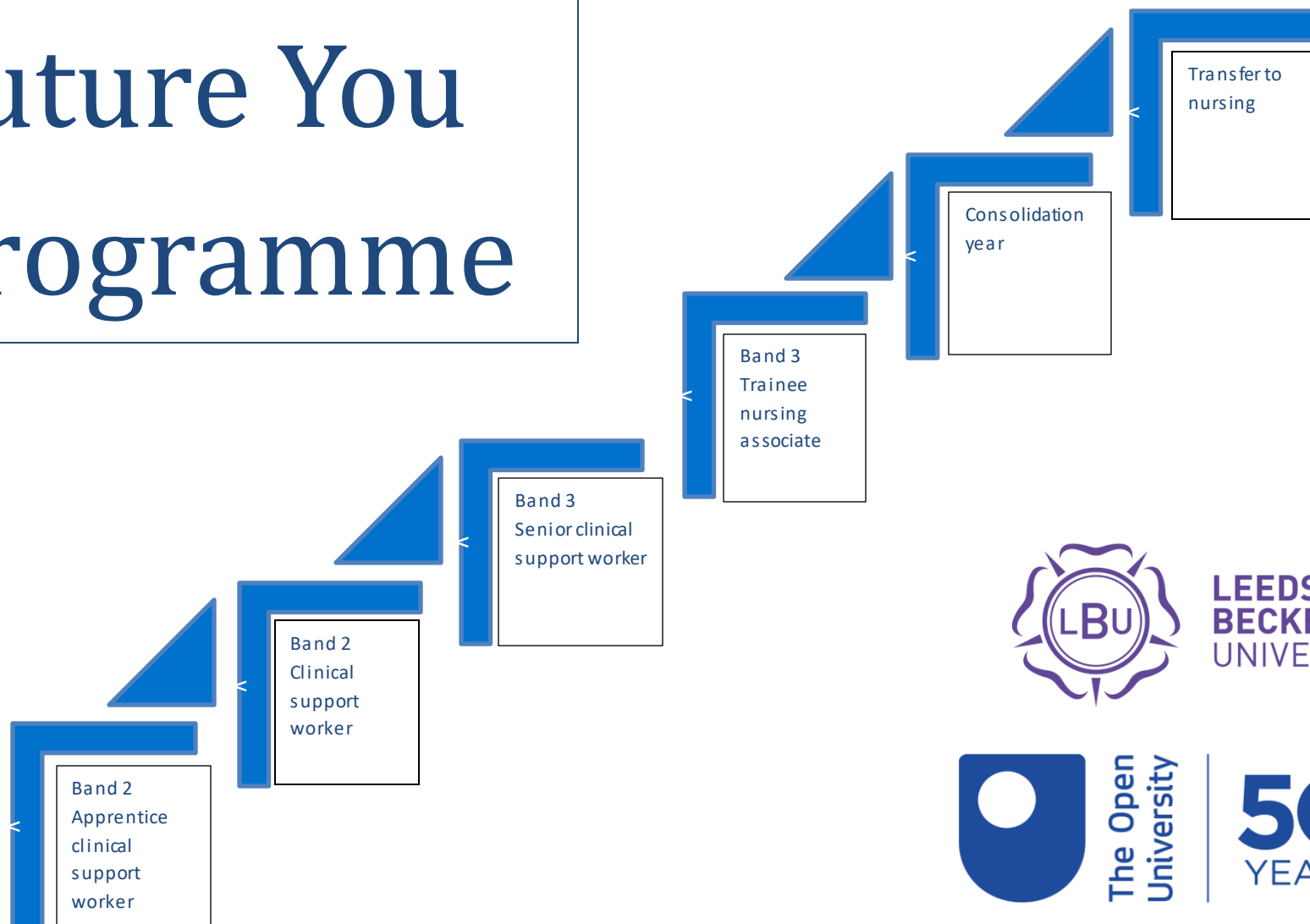
