What are T Levels?

T Levels are a new way of learning after your GCSEs. The Health T Level enables students to study theory while experiencing industry insights in the healthcare sector.

They are equivalent to three A Levels and carry UCAS points. More importantly, they are recognised nationally and will enable you to progress into a career of your choice in the healthcare sector.



How are T Levels assessed?

In year one, you will study 11 core units and two core science units. You will sit two exams at the end of the year. You will also have a practical assessment, called the employer-set project, to give you the opportunity to try out some clinical skills.

In year two, the units are all coursework assessed and you will complete an industry placement in your chosen specialism, known as your occupational specialism.



Health T Level specialisms

In year two of your course, you will be able to study a specialism that you choose.

This can be:

- Adult nursing
- Mental health nursing
- Therapies, ranging from physiotherapy, through occupational therapy to radiography



What career progression will be possible for me after the two years?

Once you have successfully completed the course, you can select one of three options. You can choose to:

- Go to university to study for a degree in health
- Progress to an apprenticeship as, for example, a trainee nurse associate
- Enter employment by, for example, working as a care assistant in a setting
