Description of the outputs

- Taxonomy of 'Employability Skills and Workplace Behaviours' - Combined industry sector responses.

Sector use

1. The combined industry sector Taxonomy can be used by teachers to identify, design, structure and deliver activities to develop learners' workplace skills and general English, Maths and Digital competencies.
2. Teachers can design activities that meet individual criterion in each taxonomy or create more complex activities which tackle one or more taxonomic areas.
3. The taxonomies were created during the TRIP project following T Level learners' self-assessment, through an employer-led ranking exercise. Nine employers were asked to rank the skills and behaviours attributed to learners as part of their self-assessment and were asked to rank them for their industry sector.
4. The Combined Industry Sector Taxonomies are the aggregated outcomes of all nine employers' rankings. The four most frequently identified skills and behaviours are included in the Taxonomies.

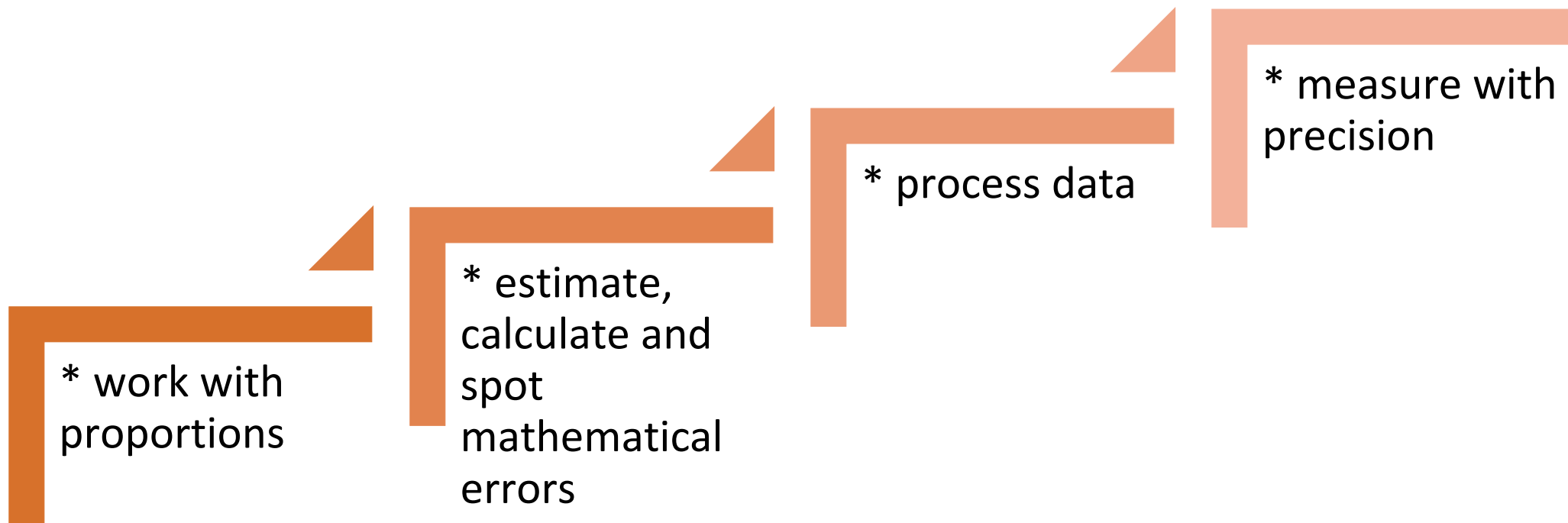
