You are moving into a new bedroom and you have to design it with 6 items in the table.

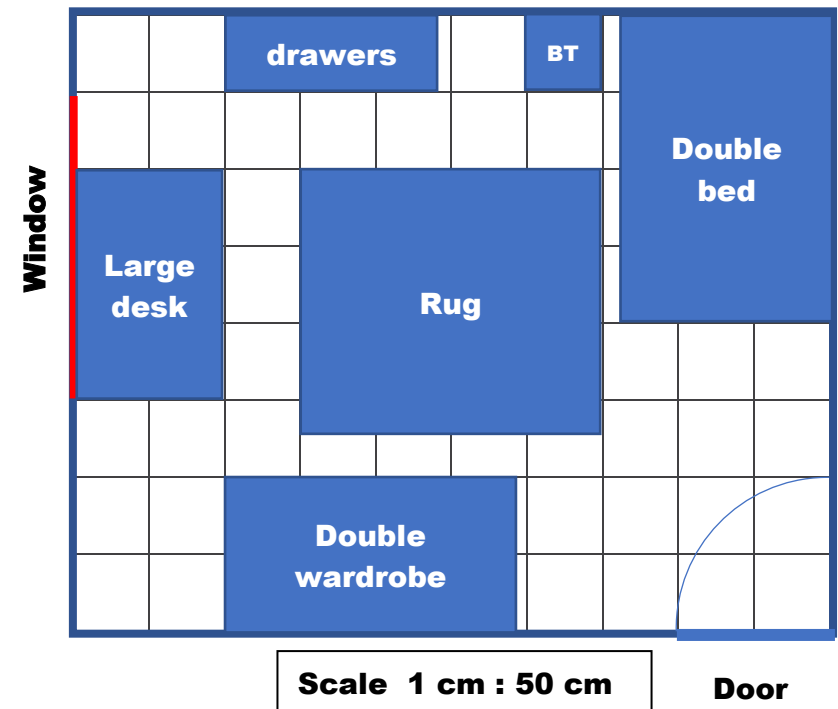
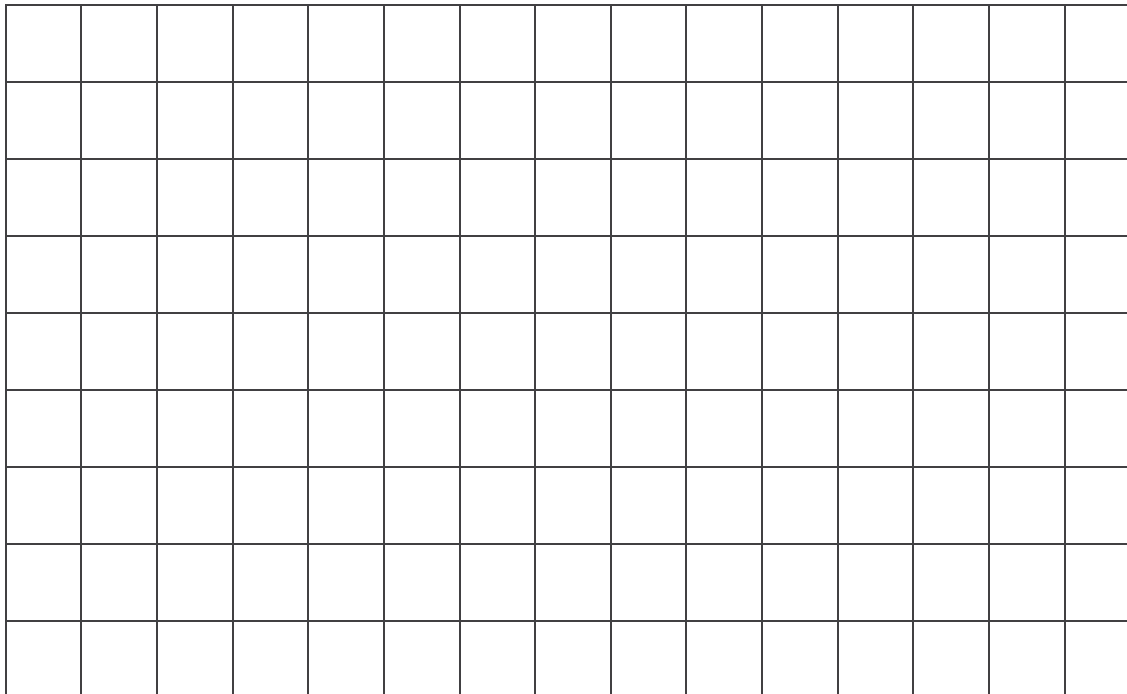
You really like looking out the window when you work so your desk needs to be by the window. You also don't want to cover up any of your rug – it's your favourite.

Rug	2.0	1.75

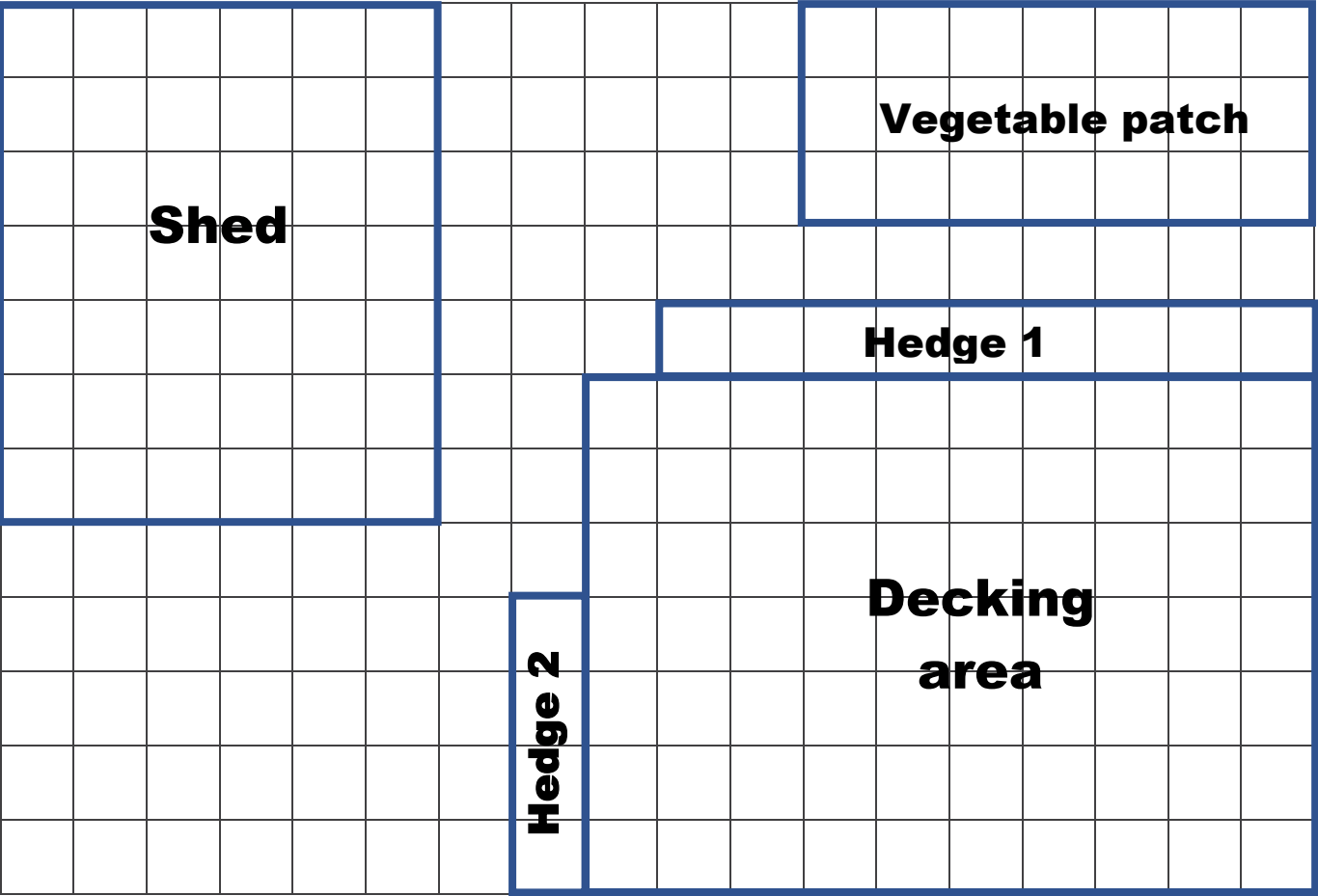
Use this practice grid to draw furniture to scale before placing them in the blue square.
